

The eGov Project Paves the Way for Modern Macedonia

The USAID funded eGov Project contributes to improving the efficiency and transparency in the Republic of Macedonia by designing, developing and implementing modern e-government solutions, thus increasing democracy and opening new channels for doing business in a transparent and secure manner.

All candidates for jobs in the state sector now enjoy the fully transparent electronic **apply online** system, which saves money for the candidates and the Civil Servants Agency alike and eliminates any type of discrimination. The obligatory testing of the candidates is done electronically, eliminating all risks for human mistakes when checking the test answers.

The Government has officially endorsed the full usage of the **electronic public procurement** system that will increase business opportunities for companies, save tax-payers money and reduce space for corrupt behavior.

All Macedonian companies, regardless of their size can file their taxes online through the **e-tax services**. The system expedites the communication between the companies and the tax authorities, improves the quality of the submitted data and saves significant amounts of time.

All truckers enjoy the easy to use online system to apply for **international cargo transport licenses** and benefit from the automated electronic system which distributes the licenses in a fully transparent and fair manner. The system also enables efficient and accurate monitoring of the use of distributed licenses.

The draft **National Budget** is timely presented to the Parliament after having been prepared over the electronic system developed by the Project. The system includes features for simulating various scenarios that could have a budgetary impact.

The health authorities are using the **e-health registries** for more structured and organized use of various databases.

The **site builder** application enables **automated distribution of various state benefits**. So far, it has mostly been used for distribution of places in student dormitories, student scholarships and loans, as well as apartments for socially deprived families. The application is expected to be widely used by other government institutions in the future.

The **accountability through transparency** application offers citizens a possibility to be informed about activities within their municipality and to express online their opinions and suggestions. It also improves the efficiency of the municipality administration.

The **single window for export/import licenses and quotas (EXIM)** gives companies easy access to a single spot to apply for and obtain licenses for import, export and transit of any commodity. It also provides for electronic application and distribution of tariff-rate quotas on a "first come, first served" basis.

The **online employment registration** system enables companies to register or terminate employments by electronically filing a simple form that requires significantly smaller number of data compared to the past. Through the system, companies and employees have permanent online access to the current and historical data regarding overall or individual employments.

The eGov Project focuses on the interest of the end users.

Companies and citizens are being informed about new applications and how to use them through **brochures and press campaigns**.

Handbooks have been produced on basic IT skills, on IT privacy and IT security.

The online **e-Learning** course www.ucenje.org.mk is available to the general public free of charge.

The Macedonia Surfing Road Show took ICT to 10 cities around the country, informing and encouraging the citizens to use e-Gov and other online services.

Through the support of the e-Gov Project **digital certificates** are now available through commercial issuers.

Workshops have been organized on IT privacy and IT security.

All these e-government applications have been developed and implemented in close cooperation with the respective partner government institutions.
